

ORDINANCE NO. 985

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 4 OF THE OFFICIAL CODE OF THE CITY OF GLASGOW (OCCG) TO REMOVE THE LICENSE REQUIREMENT FOR DANCING IN A BAR

* * * * *

WHEREAS, The City of Glasgow (the "City") is authorized by Montana law to promote the public health, safety, aesthetic appearance, and welfare of the City. Mont. Code Ann. § 7-1-4123; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has in the exercise of those powers previously established Chapter 4 of the OCCG pertaining to establishments that sell liquor; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined the existing ordinance should be amended to reflect the license and fee for dancing in such establishments are no longer necessary; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLASGOW, MONTANA:

That Section 4-55. of the OCCG is hereby repealed and abolished.

~~It shall be unlawful for a person licensed to sell alcoholic beverages under this chapter, to permit dancing on the licensed premises unless a license for such dancing has been obtained from the city.~~
